Education quality

Education is DAS's highest priority, students at this university are here to take part in education. Our education should be of the highest possible quality and students need to be able to share their opinion on the level of education.

- Ⓜ DAS is in favour of integrated subjects through, for example, projects, however it is even more important that education is accessible to students who are not able to study fulltime.
- Ⓜ There should be research aimed at the effectivity of the current education quality assurance measures.
- Ⓜ Overpopulation of studies should be prevented to ensure education quality
- Ⓜ More attention for the quality of guidance of graduation assignments in the master education.
- Ⓜ DAS pleads that study associations do not have to decrease in available space and for more self-study possibilities.
- Ⓜ Lectures made available online so they can be watched later.
- Ⓜ DAS is completely against evening lectures.
- Ⓜ There should be standardised exam free weeks per study



Ambition

Studentactivism is, in the eyes of DAS, the most important way in which students can develop themselves besides their study. Whether this is a board year, a committee, topsport, or a job, everyone should get the opportunity to develop themselves on a personal level.

- Ⓜ DAS wants an evident UT certificate which recognizes studentactivism of multiple kinds.
- Ⓜ More opportunity for initiatives and support for them.
- Ⓜ Starting with lecture year 2020-2021 separate subjects besides integrated modules are available. DAS will make sure this is executed correctly and there is a pliant transition period.
- Ⓜ The University should have an active communication strategy to students what is possible besides studying.
- Ⓜ There should be more attention and information about the possibilities for plus- and honoursprogrammes.
- Ⓜ The University should support Dreamteams more and DAS supports the building of a potential Dreamteam hall.
- Ⓜ DAS sees a gap in support for start-ups and feels this gap should be filled.
- Ⓜ DAS wants the boardminor to return.
- Ⓜ FOBOS regulations should be equal and realistic.





Participation

-  DAS feels program committees, faculty councils, and the university council should be professionalized more.
-  DAS is committed to active promotion of participation within the University.





Internationalization
